The tri-chassis C1000 offers the choice of solid state, vacuum tube or both. Music handling is accomplished in its own shielded from noise, dual mono, preamplifier module. The preamp may be ordered in either tube or solid state designs and yields over 130 dB of channel separation for ultimate stereo fidelity. Combined, all three modules feature 18 source selections including both Phono MM and MC, any of the source selections can be amplified by either the Tube or the Solid State preamplifier sections.

The C1000 is a fully balanced, dual mono design from input to output. The Left and Right channel circuits are separated by an aluminum shield. Even the power supplies are totally separate. Input switching is done by Electromagnetic switches, two for the left channel and two for the right. Balanced and unbalanced switched audio outputs for SPKR 1 and SPKR 2 are provided to control additional amplifiers in remote areas or for multi amp speaker requirements. Phono section flexibility contains moving magnet with adjustable capacitance from the remote to allow flexibility in matching a favorite turntable and moving coil offers adjustable resistance from the remote control.

The C1000 Preamplifier will be officially introduced at CEDIA trade show in Indianapolis, IN. Available
